



POLICY CONCERNING POLITICAL ACTIVITY  
Approved by the Board of Trustees September 17, 2018

- A. Chatham Education Foundation Trustees and Volunteers shall not claim, imply, or suggest that any political office holder or candidate or any political activity engaged in by the Trustee or Volunteer has been approved by or endorsed by CEF, including by using or permitting the use of CEF's name in a manner that implies support by CEF.
- B. Chatham Education Foundation shall not approve as Trustees holders of or candidates for any elected office if such office would create a conflict to interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest.
- C. In attending events sponsored by Chatham Education Foundation, Trustees and Volunteers shall not display support for any candidate for or holder of an elected office.
- D. The Executive Committee may grant exceptions to this policy.
